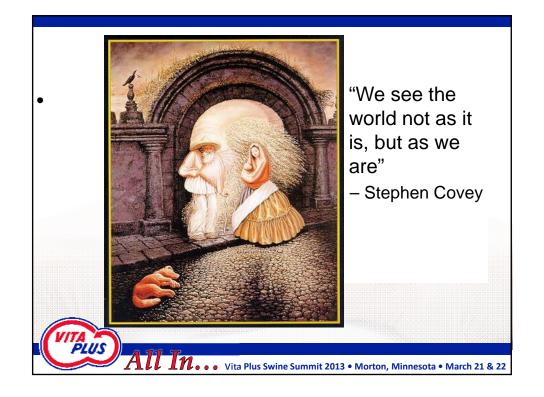

- Mark Fields Pres of Ford Motor Co. made it famous!



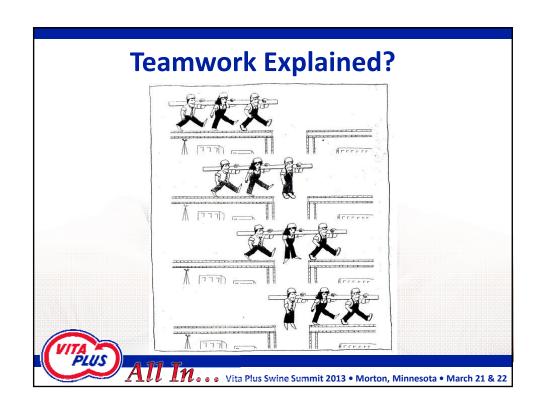
