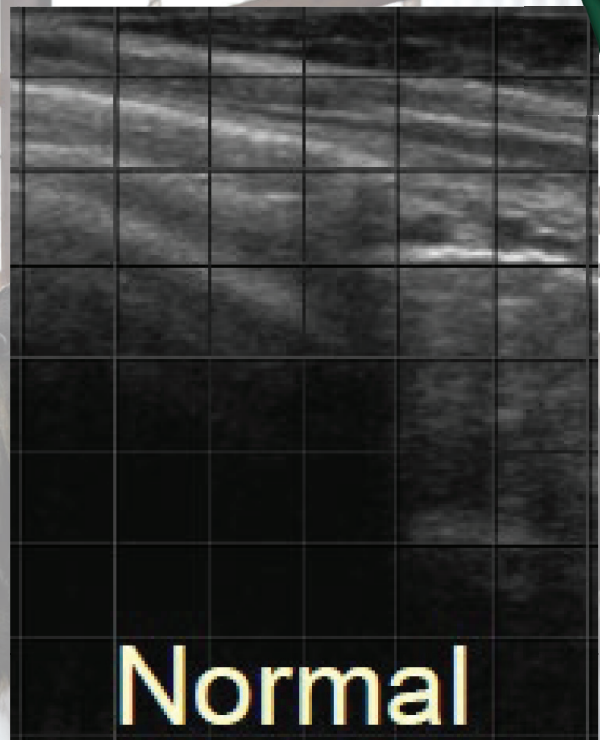
Scoring System



- 0 = Normal
- 1 = Comet tailing (variation of normal)
- 2 = Lobular lesion
- 3 = Lobar lesion
- 4 = 2 lobar lesions
- 5 = 3 or more lobar lesions

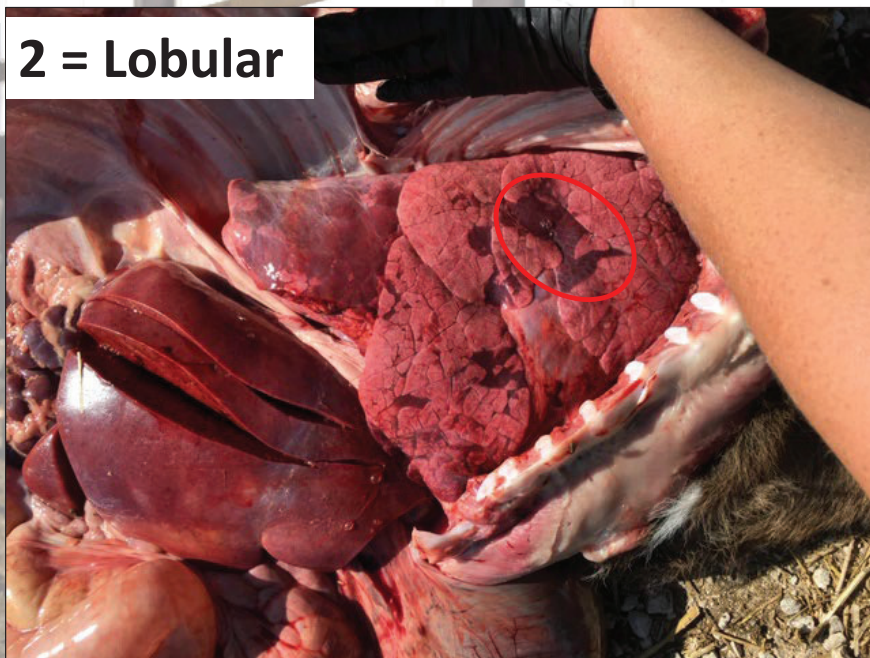

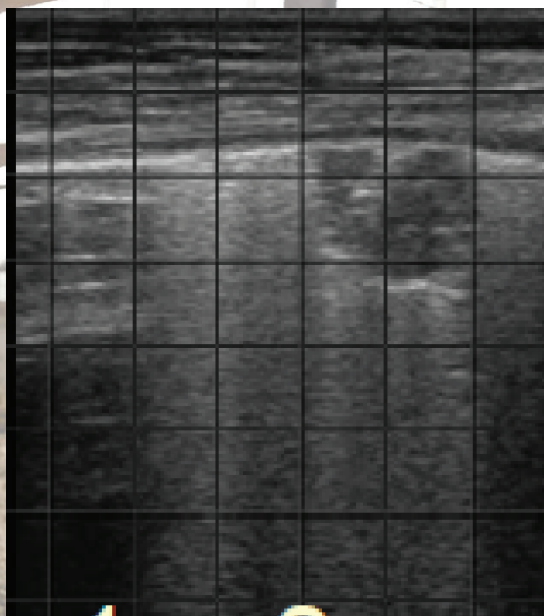

2 = Lobular

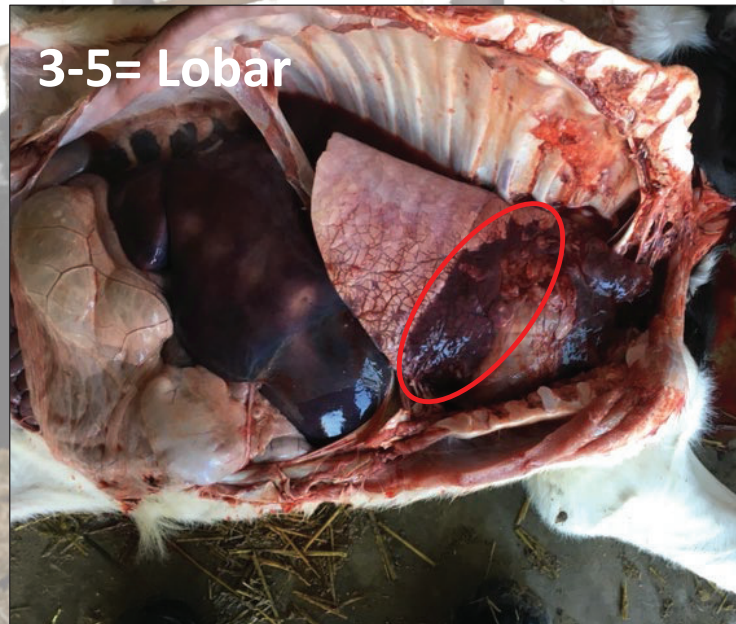

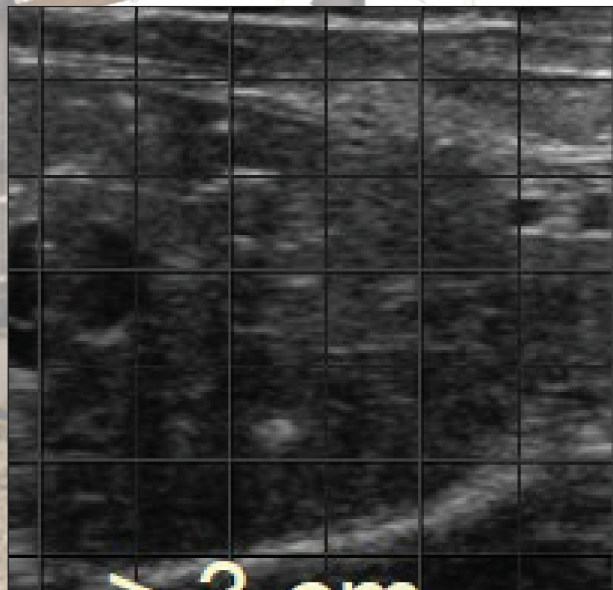

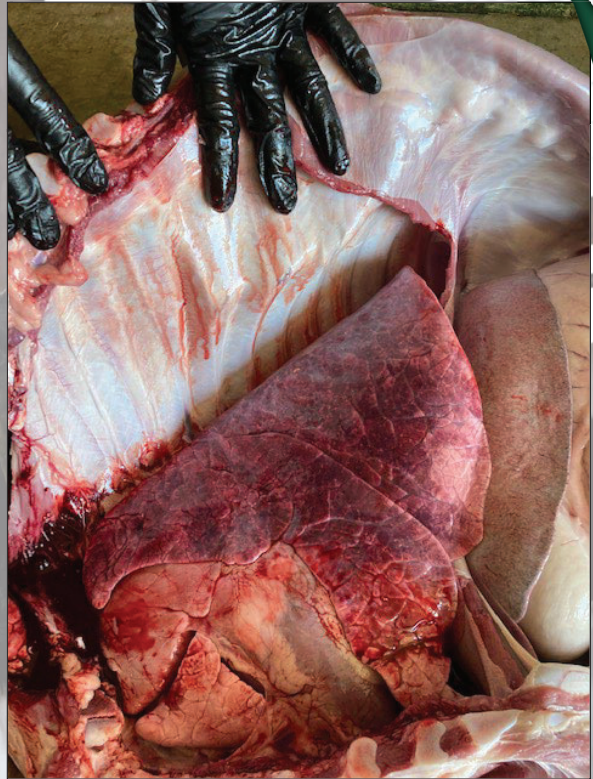

Lobar Pneumonia on Ultrasound



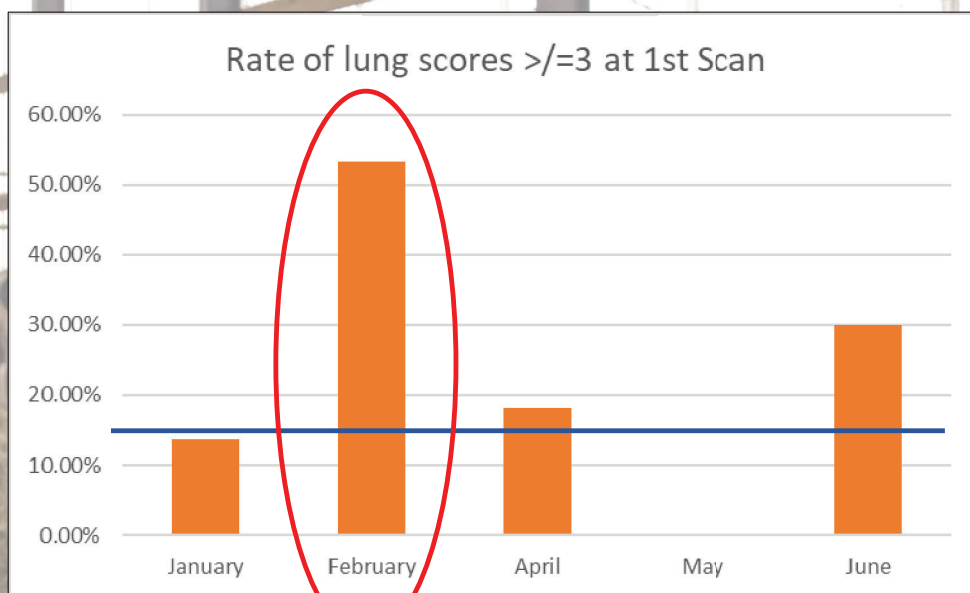
What do I See Inside the Calf?



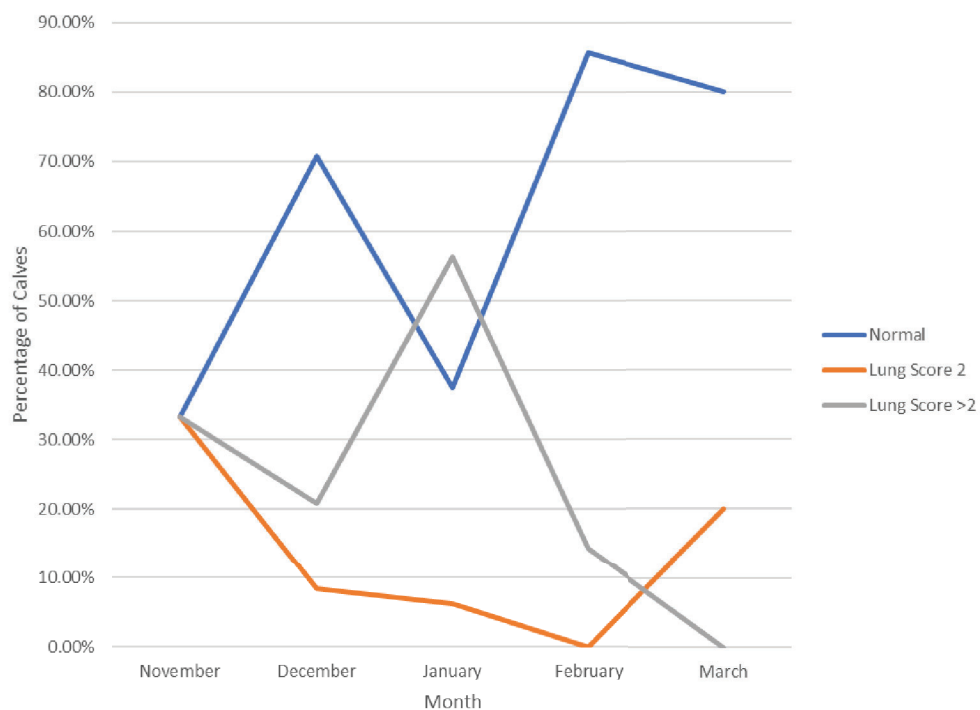
WeanClean™

- Weaning – how many have pneumonia at the start of weaning? Goal: < 15%
- Start of treatment – how many score > 3 or < 2 at their first treatment? Goal: < 15%
- 7-10 d after treatment – how many score > 2 after their first treatment? Goal: < 15%
- 12×7 scans – starting at 7d of age, scan 12 at 7d intervals to find high-risk age group

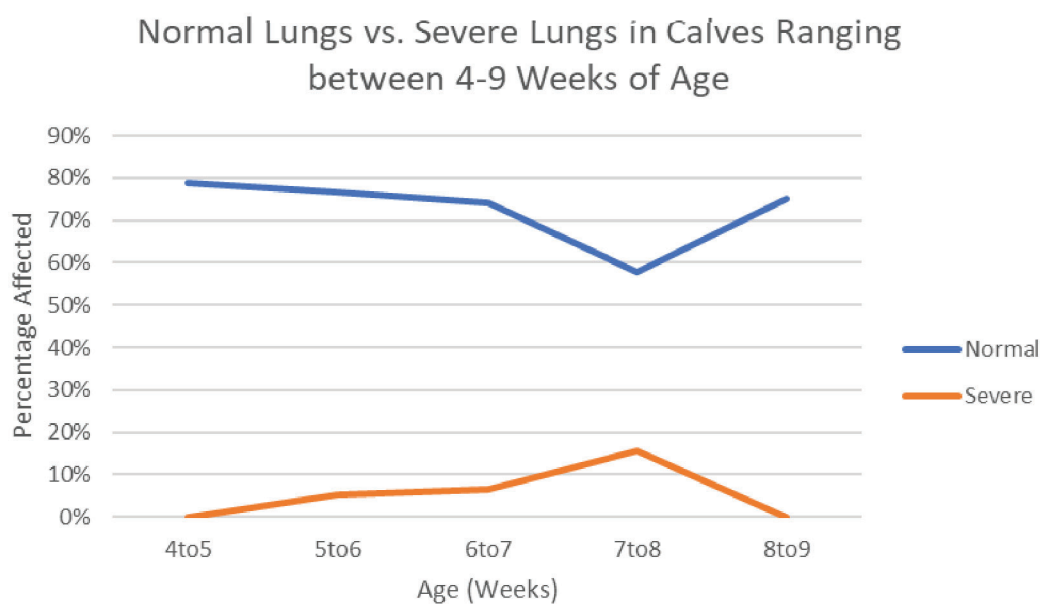

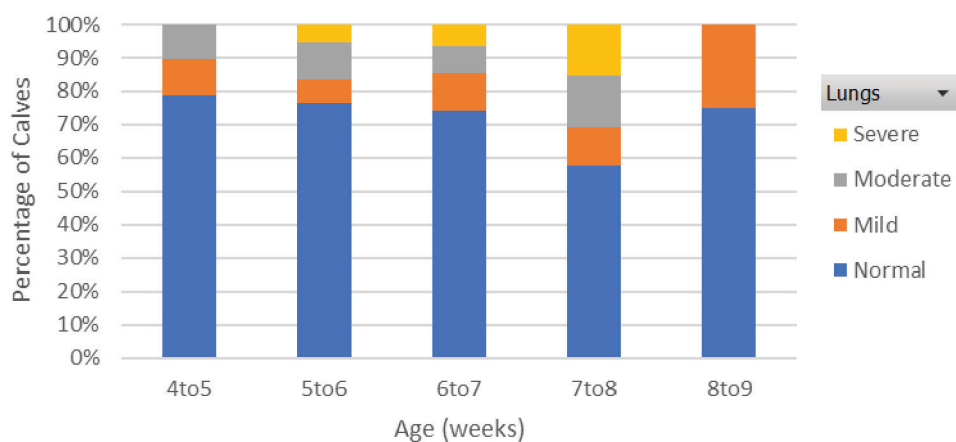

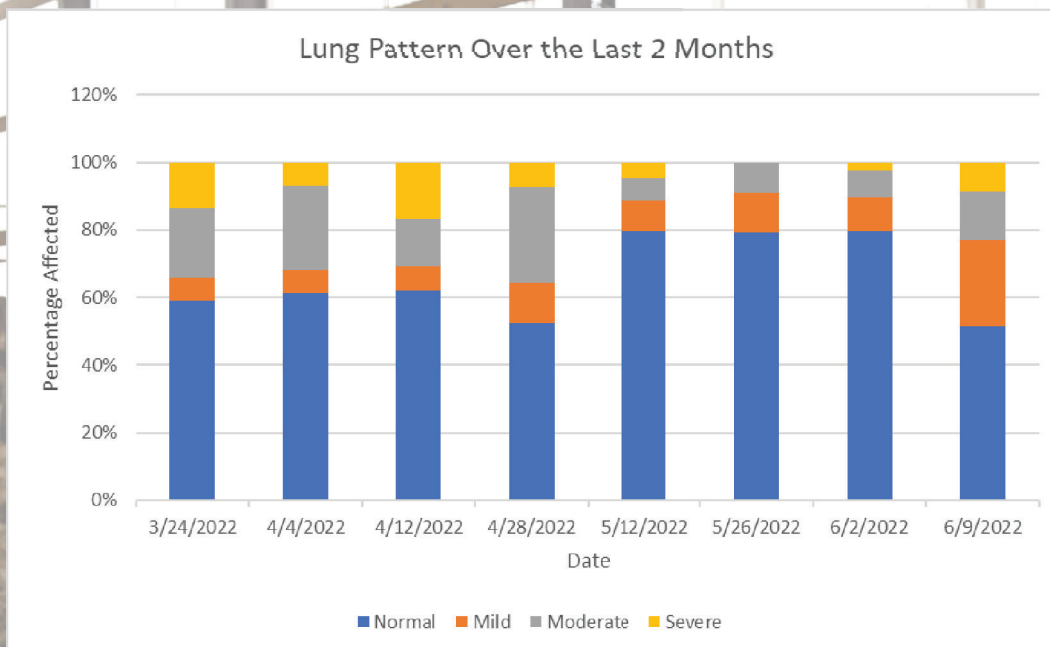
Count of Calf ID

Breakdown of Lung Lesions from 4-9 Weeks of Age

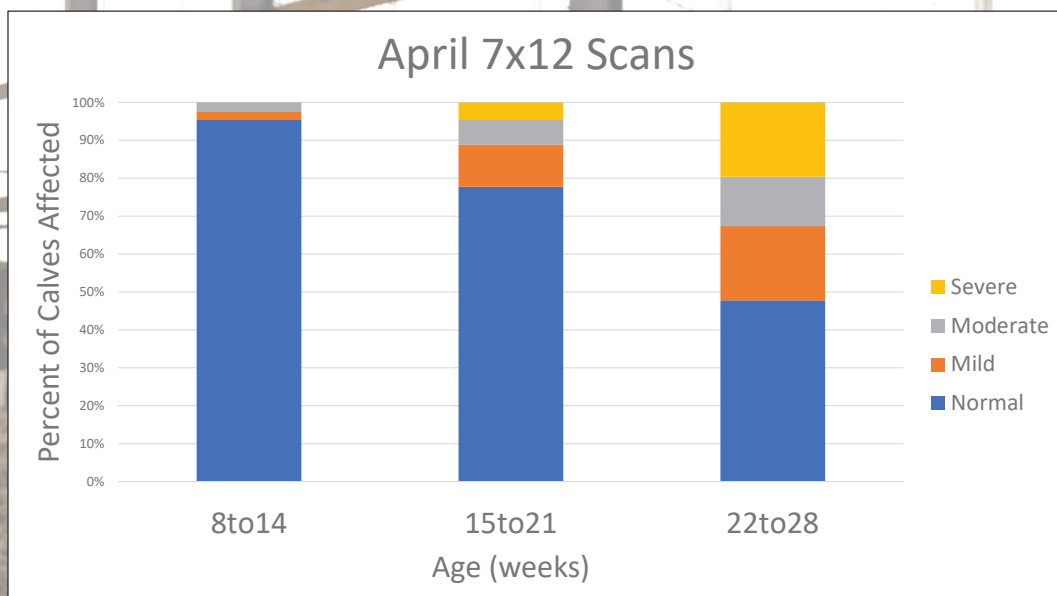

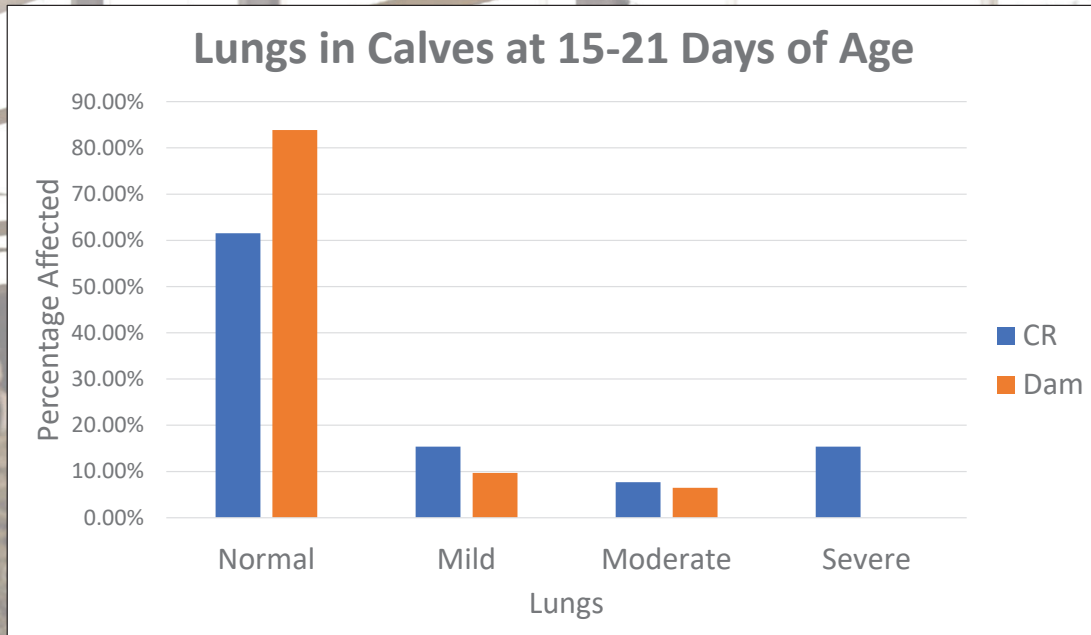
